Introduction

Inviting others to experience the love of Jesus through the local church isn't about growing an organization—it's about impacting lives.

- 1. Have you ever been invited to something that changed your life in some way? (A job opportunity, a new friend group, a fitness program, etc.)
- 2. What was your first experience attending Access Church? Did anything stand out to you?

Discussion Questions

- 1. Why Another Church?
 - Rich was asked, "*Did Jacksonville really need another church?*" How would you answer that question?
 - What makes a church "needed" or "effective" in a community?
- 2. The Story of Mike & Kate
 - **Mike & Kate's** fictional (but realistic) journey highlights the struggles people face in finding a church home. What stood out to you in their story?
 - Have you ever felt like church was confusing, irrelevant, or intimidating? What changed that for you?
 - Rich emphasized that rather than saying "*You should try our church*," the best invitation is "**Come sit with me.**" Why do you think a personal invitation makes such a difference?
 - Have you ever invited someone to church? What happened?
- 3. Church Begins in the Parking Lot
 - The message pointed out that before Rich even starts preaching, guests have already had a sermon preached to them—through the way they are welcomed.
 Have you ever had a first impression of a place (positive or negative) that shaped your experience?
 - How do you think our church does at making people feel welcome? What can we do better?
- 4. Jesus & the Feeding of the 5,000 (Matthew 14:13-21)
 - Read Matthew 14:13-21 (the feeding of the 5,000).
 - Why do you think Jesus told the disciples, "You give them something to eat"?
 - What does this story teach us about trusting God with our small offerings?

- Rich pointed out that many in the crowd probably had food but didn't offer it. Only one boy stepped forward.
 - What are some things you might be "holding back" from offering to God?
- How can we take a step of faith like the boy with the loaves and fish?
- 5. Serving in the Church
 - **Derrick and Laura** shared their journey of hesitantly stepping into serving but finding fulfillment and joy. If you are currently serving, what have you learned from it?
 - If you're not yet serving, what holds you back?
 - How does serving make church feel more personal?

Practical Application

- Think of someone in your life who might be like **Mike & Kate**—searching for hope but not sure where to turn. How can you invite them to experience church personally?
- This week, consider saying, "Come sit with me."
- Consider ways to **serve** in the church.
- Where do you feel God nudging you to step up?
- What's one next step you can take to use your time or gifts for God's kingdom?

Closing Reflection & Prayer

- Pray for the courage to invite others and to step into serving where God is calling.
- Ask God to help our church continue to be a place where people feel **welcomed, valued, and loved**.
