- 6. Read 2 Kings 5:13. Who in your life would be willing to speak words of truth to you and call out your pride?
- 7. Read 2 Kings 5:14. Why do you think God gave Naaman skin like a young boy instead of just restoring his skin to its aged, scarred, former state?
- 8. What if Naaman had believed in God, but not washed in the Jordan? Why do you think the washing mattered? What's a modern-day parallel for us as believers?
- 9. Rich said, "The size of your pride and the size of your God are directly proportional." How does that apply in your life?
- 10. What is one small thing you can do in 2022 to make God big in your life?
